Scope of Request

The purpose of this Request for Application (RFA) is to solicit responses from both licensed Child Placing Agencies (CPA) and community organizations which are dedicated to expanding foster care capacity in Region 2 (Big Country & Texoma Communities). Providers and community partners may submit a proposal for one or more of the following categories:

- Initiatives such as presentations in the communities, foster parent support groups, or any activity intended to increase the availability of foster parents in Region 2.
- Capacity building support for in-network Providers to serve youth with high needs
- Children/youth with an Intellectual Developmental Disability (IDD)
- Children/youth with Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- Sibling Groups
- Medically Fragile
- Professional Foster Homes

Proposals are expected to provide solid and measurable objectives in their application that directly relate to one of the above categories. Respondent must include the number of children and family they expect to impact with their proposal. Additionally, the budget included with the proposal must be as specific as possible regarding the amounts of spending in each category. The respondent must either be a licensed Child Placing Agency (CPA) in the state of Texas in good contractual standing with 2INgage or a community partner such as a nonprofit or church that intends to use funds towards recruiting and/or supporting foster families. Eligible counties include Archer, Baylor, Brown, Callahan, Clay, Coleman, Comanche, Cottle, Eastland, Fisher, Foard, Hardeman, Haskell, Jack, Jones, Kent, Knox, Mitchell, Montague, Nolan, Runnels, Scurry, Shackelford, Stephens, Stonewall, Taylor, Throckmorton, Wichita, Wilbarger, and Young.

The total amount for this RFA is \$175,000 and extends to August 31, 2025. Each Provider will be allocated a designated amount based on their proposal and requested funding amount.

Expectations of Grantees

Grantees are expected to submit monthly reports to 2INgage regarding any progress towards outcomes in the previous month. An accounting of any activities and/or spending is expected in these reports. They are due the 5th working day of the following month.
